

# Support Material Risk Assessment Plan for Mid Coast Careers Market

This information is provided for the use of schools and teachers and may assist with the preparation of your risk assessment which covers the attendance of individual or groups of students at the Mid Coast Careers Market.

This document is only to be used to assist you in your Risk Assessment which will need to be completed by individual schools.

This event is available as a school excursion and should reflect the relevant school policies and procedures to ensure duty of care is maintained by the supervising teachers.

#### Venue

The Mid Coast Careers Market is conducted at the Port Macquarie Race Club, located on the Oxley Highway 3km from the Port Macquarie town centre. Activities will occur in designated areas including the two pavilions and undercover area of the venue.

Should any vehicle need to use the designated roadway within Race Club precinct, their speed will be limited to a 10Kmph speed limit.
